

NEW OFFICIAL CERTIFICATION STEPS

Follow these steps to be added as a new official with US Lacrosse, access the eLearning Portal at learning.uslacrosse.org, and be processed correctly by ArbiterSports for your organization's game assignments.

1. Create a membership by joining or renewing with US lacrosse

- a) Online at www.uslacrosse.org
- b) Over the phone: Call 410-235-6882 ex. 102

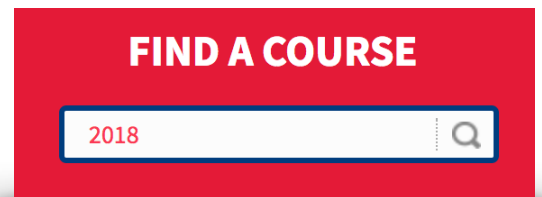

2. Visit learning.uslacrosse.org for the Online Course and Rules Exams

- a) Login with your US Lacrosse username and password
- b) Your membership provides FREE access to all courses and exams

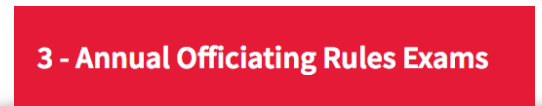
3. Complete the 2018 Boys' Lacrosse Rules Online Course

- a) Search for "2018"
- b) Click on "catalog"
- c) Add course to your cart
- d) Proceed to checkout
- e) Launch course
- f) Send certificate to your Certified Trainer upon completion



4. Pass the 2018 Rules Exams

- a) Search for "2018"
- b) Click on "catalog"
- c) Add exams to your cart
- d) Junior Officials must pass the:
 - i. NFHS **AND** Youth Boys' Lacrosse Rule Exams
- e) Level 1 Adult Officials must pass the:
 - i. NFHS **OR** Collegiate Boys' Lacrosse Rules Exams*
 - *Your trainer will inform you which exam you need to take



5. Complete a minimum of 8 classroom training hours

- a) Conducted by a US Lacrosse Certified Trainer
- b) Hosted by your lacrosse official's organization

6. Pass a field evaluation

- a) Conducted by a US Lacrosse Certified Observer
- b) During the regular or the offseason
